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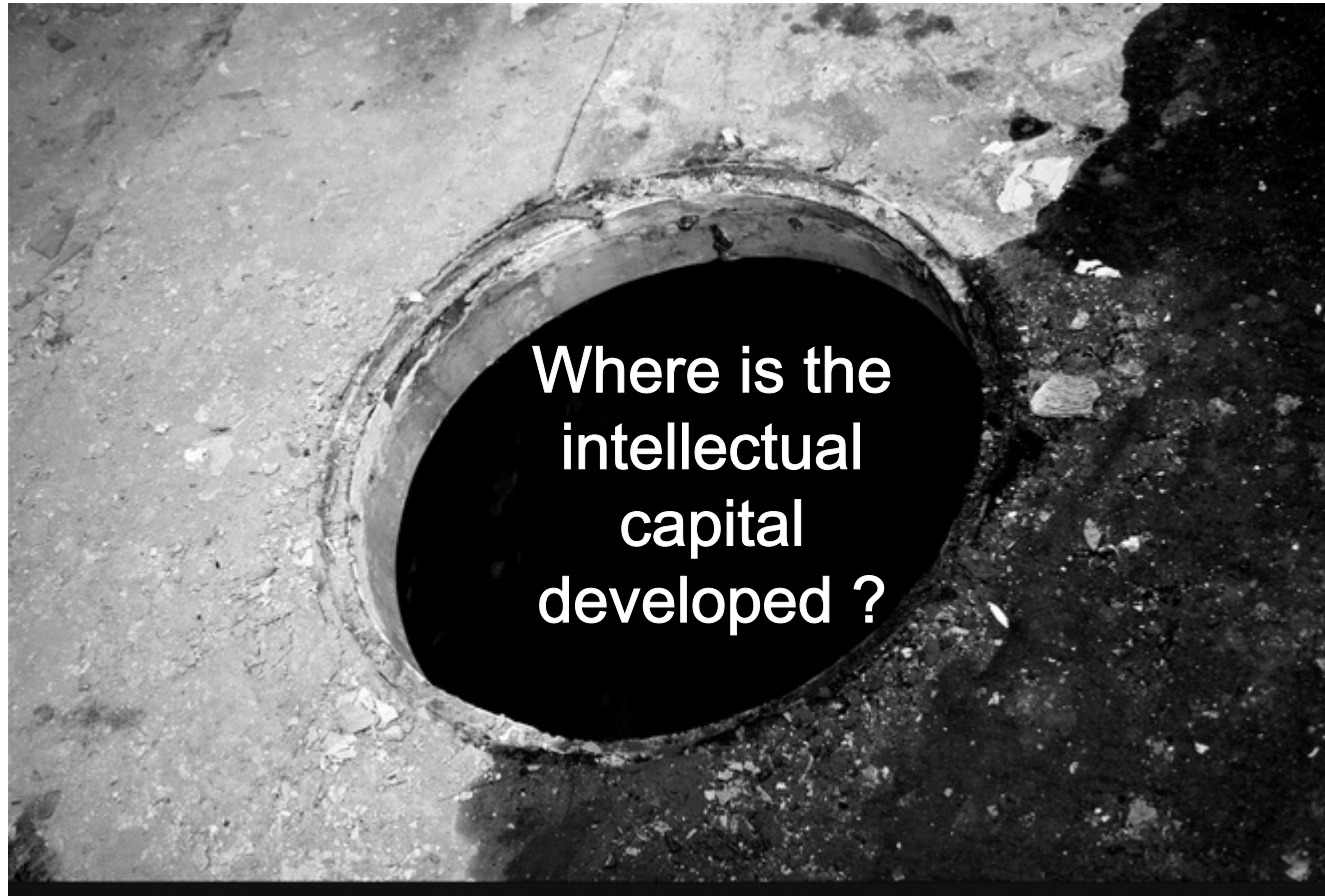

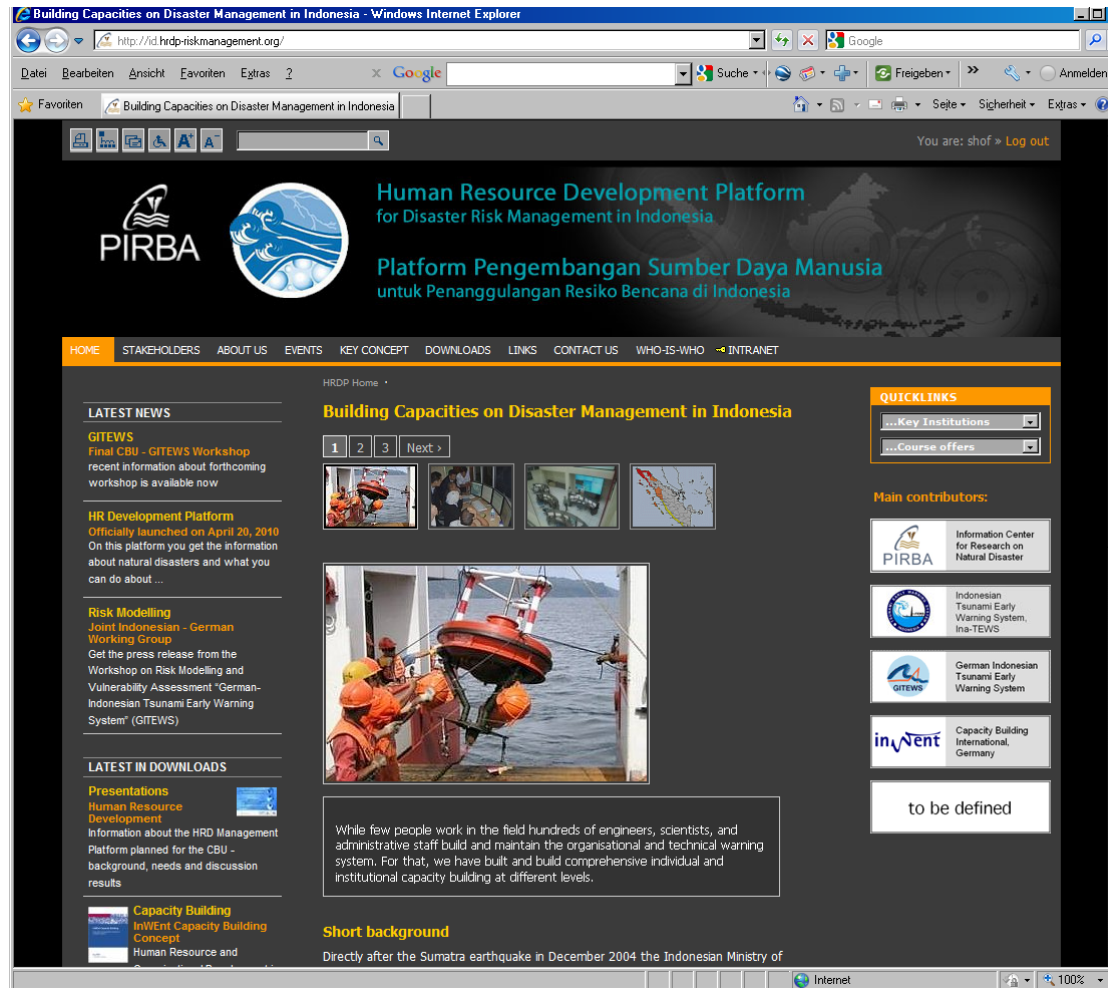

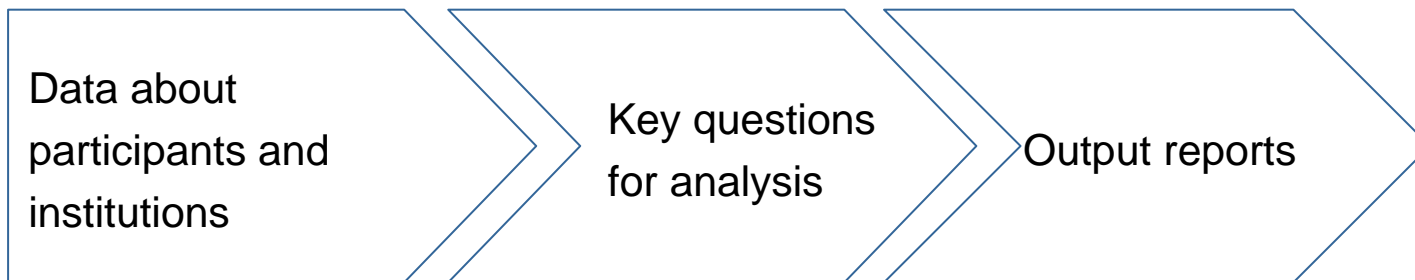

## Where do we stand ? (1)

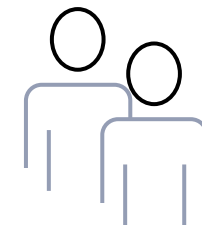
- 210 detailed event records about disaster risk management available

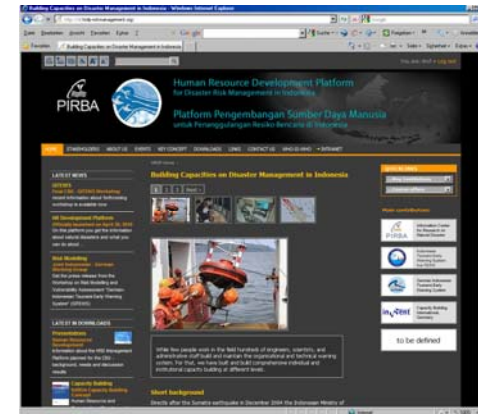

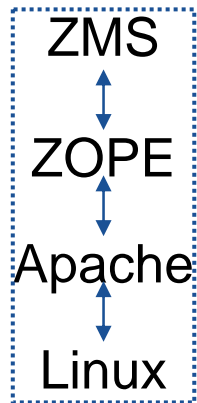
